

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has banned the disposal of “sharps” and needles in regular household trash, including the blue Natick trash bags as well as in trash collected by a private trash hauler.

Proper Disposal of Used Needles / Sharps



The Natick Board of Health is providing a safe & convenient way for Natick residents to properly dispose their used home needles/sharps.


During regular business hours Natick residents can deposit their spent needles/sharps container in the kiosk located on the second floor at Town Hall, 13 East Central St.

Only one quart containers specifically designed for needles/sharps can be put into the kiosk.

No other containers will be accepted.

Town Hall hours are:

8:00 to 5:00	Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday
8:00 to 7:00	Thursday
8:00 to 12:30	Friday



This disposal resource is solely for spent needles/sharps created from personal use by Natick residents.

The term “home needles/sharps” does not include needles/sharps generated by home health aides, visiting nurses or any other person providing a professional service in a private residence.

The kiosk is a secured leak-proof collection receptacle, the contents of which are inaccessible to unauthorized personnel.
