These references should be in separately sealed envelopes, and the reference writer should sign their name across the back flap of the letter. You must follow this procedure carefully or your application may be considered incomplete.

Official High School Transcript:

Please enclose an **official** copy of your High School Transcript.

Standardized Test Scores (optional):

Please include your standardized test scores. These may be printed from your College Board or ACT Account.

*If you are under 18 years old, this application must be signed by you **and** your parent/guardian.*
