YARD WASTE PICK UP

SPRING: the first two full weeks in May on your trash day

FALL: (based on your trash day)

Tuesday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 4

Wednesday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 11

Thursday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 18

Friday Trash Day: Monday, Nov 25

CHRISTMAS TREES (BARE ONLY, NO BAG): the first two full weeks in January on your trash day

Yard waste (except for Christmas trees) must be in paper bags or marked rubbish barrels. **PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED**

BULKY WASTE

If it won't fit in a Pay-As-You-Throw bag, it's a bulky item.

Bulky waste pick-ups are available for a fee every Monday (except for Monday holidays and Fall Yard Waste Mondays).

Payment must be made at the DPW on or before the Thursday prior to the Monday pick-up no later than 3 PM.

Note, prices vary by item and many items are not accepted.

2019 - 2020 CURBSIDE COLLECTION CALENDAR



All trash and recycling must be placed curbside by 7AM. Recycling bins must be placed curbside with the open end facing out for automated pick-up or it will not be picked up. Call 508-647-6562 to determine your bin color. No recycling, bulky waste, or trash is collected on holidays. Monday holidays will not affect your regular trash day. *Please note the DPW Main Office will be closed Monday, November 11th in observance of Veteran's Day, however yard waste collection will not be affected.

Located on West Street near the corner of Route 27

Thursday & Friday 8 AM - 12 PM

Saturday & Sunday 8 AM - 3:30 PM

Acceptance of ANY recyclables is subject to refusal without published notice due to compliance to Federal and/or State restrictions.

All residents may drop off Single Stream Recyclables and the below items at the Recycling Center:

Motor Oil	Fluorescent & Compact Bulbs	Metal Items
Yard Waste	Thermometers & Thermostats	Cardboard & Paper
Paint	Books	Rigid Plastics
Batteries	Shoes & Used Clothing	Styrofoam

PAINT SWAP SHED

Open during regular Recycling Center hours from April 1st through October 31st.

Accepts latex & oil-based paints ONLY, up to 5 gallons per resident.

Stains and thinners are NOT ALLOWED.

Usable leftover paint is available to residents.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

The Recycling Center CANNOT accept Hazardous Waste. Natick partners with 10+ communities to offer collection days throughout the year.

PLEASE BE COURTEOUS



Recycling totes need to be 3 feet from objects including additional totes. Please ensure totes are 5 feet from vehicles.
