### NOTIFICATION BACON STREET WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Dear Project Abutter:

The Town of Natick, Department of Public Works is notifying you of the upcoming construction project in Bacon Street. The project will include replacing aging water main and water services in Bacon Street. The project will include trench paving this year followed by full road width paving completed in the spring of 2021.

The project includes replacing approximately 1,000 linear feet of water pipe in Bacon Street, starting at the Oak Street intersection and ending at House #17 Bacon Street. The Contract drawings can be viewed on-line at the Natick website ([natickma.org](http://natickma.org)) or a paper copy at the Natick Department of Public Works.

We anticipate the work to start on June 8, 2020 and be completed this Summer. Anticipated work hours are 7:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday thru Friday.

We realize our water main replacement project may cause some inconvenience for those who live on the street. We will work closely with the Contractor and the Natick Police Department to minimize the traffic disruptions and we will do our best to see that the construction goes smoothly.

The Town has contracted with Haley and Ward to provide project oversight during construction. The Town will email weekly project updates, and the Town will place updated information on their website.
